

## CODE OF CONDUCT:

The Code of Conduct promotes the primary interest and public safety at Heaven & Earth Trials.

All participants, clients or guests, must adhere to this code of conduct.

### 1. HORSES:

- Horses have right of way at all times.
- All horses must be groomed before tacking up.
- While grooming please inspect horse for health issues such as, nasal discharge, runny or inflamed eyes, coughing, laboured breathing, lameness, fits or staggering, severe diarrhoea, bleeding or lacerated body parts, repeated or continues rolling, pawing, kicking at abdomen or sweating (colic symptoms), excessive scratching.
- After riding, horses must be cooled down and cleaned.
- No horses to be left unattended in the arena, lunge ring or stables.

### 2. RIDER SAFETY AND CONDUCT:

- All participants/guests, must conduct themselves in consideration and respect for fellow participants as well as horses.
- No running, shouting or loud noises are allowed on premises.
- All participants/guests, must wear the appropriate riding hat and closed shoes.
- All under aged children must be under adult supervision at all times.
- For safety reasons, no pets are allowed.
- Smoking is not permitted at the stables.
- Be mindful when swishing ropes, sticks and crops in close proximity of horses
- NO MOUNTING/RIDING of any horse WITHOUT THE INSTRUCTOR present.
- Any single rider going on a trail ride, must inform of the route and horse taken to the group
- All riders must slow down to a walking pace when meeting other riders or any type of vehicle.
- Horses are not to be ridden into the stable block.

### 3. TACK & STABLES

- All horses have their own allocated grooming kit, bridles and saddles and should not be exchanged with another horse's tack.
- All bits must be thoroughly rinsed after use.
- Tack to be returned to its rightful place.
- All damaged , broken or lost tack must be reported ASAP.
- All personal tack is to be housed in each private locker.(including caps, tops,)
- Stables must be left neat and tidy before you leave.

THE GATES TO ALL PADDOCKS MUST BE KEPT CLOSED AT ALL TIMES, EVEN IF THERE IS NO HORSE IN THAT SPECIFIC ENCLOSURE.
